**All things are connected:** All things hold together. Bringing God's love to bear lifts everything. There is an inseparable bond between concern for nature, justice for the poor, commitment to society and interior peace.

**Joy:** Our Christian joy is rooted in the truth of our faith that God exists and that God is love.

**Compassion:** Pope Francis sees so much human suffering, and in that suffering he hears the voice of God calling to our world to change - to become fair, just, to show respect for our planet and for each person.

**Hope:** God is at work among us, actively building a society of love. Our task is to cooperate with this activity wherever we find it. Whatever issues we are tackling, God is already there at work before us.

**Calm:** We need to develop in ourselves a spirit of calm and prayer rooted in hope - so that in the midst of the challenges and difficulties of our world we never lose our sense of the presence of God.

**Urgency:** Pope Francis compares the Church to a field hospital in a battlefield. As in any field hospital, we have to make priorities - some wounds are more urgent.
