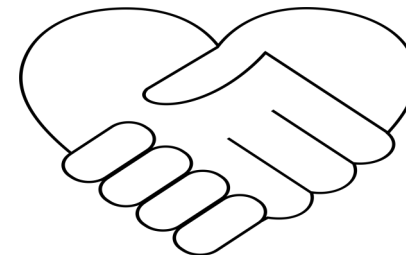
## Some things never change

In 1925 Pope Pius XI instituted today's Feast of Christ the King, to remind people of the Kingship of Christ. With "Christ's way" ruling the earth there would be a more peaceful world.

The Pope worried that the voice of Christ was being lost. He wrote "...these manifold evils in the world were due to the fact that the majority of men had thrust Jesus Christ and his hold law out of their lives; that these had no place either in private affairs or in politics."

Today Pope Francis is worried for the same reason. In a world "pervaded by Consumerism...God's voice is no longer heard, the quiet joy of his love is no longer felt, and the desire to do good fades."

Today let us acknowledge Christ as our King. His rule and his voice should be in our hearts, in our wills and visible in our mercy and kindness.
