Guidelines from Bishop Denis on the celebration of funerals in churches throughout the diocese.

Words of Remembrance

I want families to be aware that this is something that no family should ever feel they have to do. If a family wishes to share words of remembrance, the following practices are expected:

- Only one person, a relative or friend of the deceased, speaks on behalf of the family.
- The words to be said are to be scripted, agreed by the priest celebrant and last no longer than three minutes.
- The content of the sharing needs to focus on words of appreciation of the person who has died and of their faith and might also include thanks for support received around the time of death.

The choice of Music:

The music selected needs to support our faith and enhance our prayer.

The family needs to agree all music choices with the priest celebrant ahead of time. (Or they can ask the person leading the music or a member of the parish funeral ministry team to check and agree the music with the priest).
