Is the Mass Changing?

The structure of the Mass is not changing. Its order and the actions of the Mass remain unchanged. The readings at Mass are not changed.

However, with the introduction of the new edition of the Roman Missal we will notice a change in how the Mass sounds. The translations from the original Latin of a significant number of our prayers texts have changed—sometimes by just a change in a particular word or in the word order.

Prayers that we have become used to reciting by memory will need to be relearned. Prayers that we are used to hearing the priest say will sound different to us. The style of language we will hear may seem more formal to us and perhaps in parts, more complex. But over time, with the praying of these texts, the sound of the Mass will again become familiar to us.
