When a University professor and his wife spoke out strongly against a new government which had come to power in their country they were placed under house arrest.

For a long time the couple appealed unsuccessfully for their release and that of their two young children.

In time the government agreed that the couple would be released on the basis that they left the country bringing with them possessions to a maximum weight of 200lbs - 90 kg.

The couple agreed on a list of their most important things which they placed in three boxes in their hall way.

When the authorities arrived to transport them to the airport, the couple pointed to their most important possessions in the three boxes. The authorities asked "and how much do your children weigh"?

The family left the country in the clothes they were wearing and with what they could carry. We all take for granted the most fundamental things in our lives.

One of those fundamental things is the annual harvest of grains, fruits, and vegetables which feeds us each year and which we celebrate and thank God for today.

Every year the harvest happens. And we have enough. We take it for granted. Let us be conscious of this fundamental part of our lives and thank God. He "gave us this day our daily bread".
